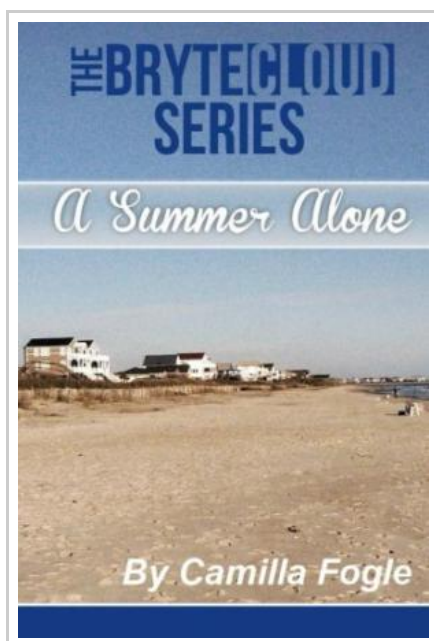




A Summer Alone
