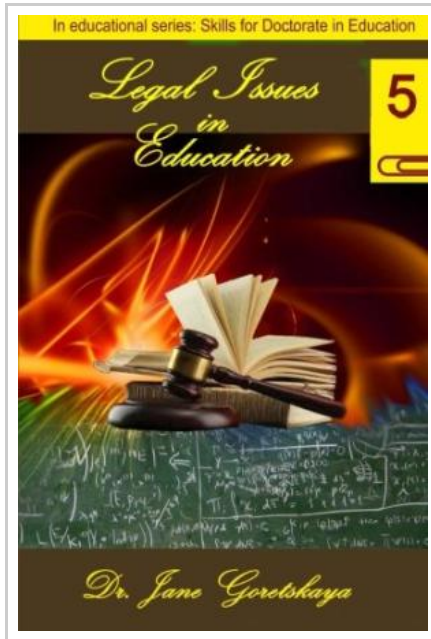




Legal Issues in Education
