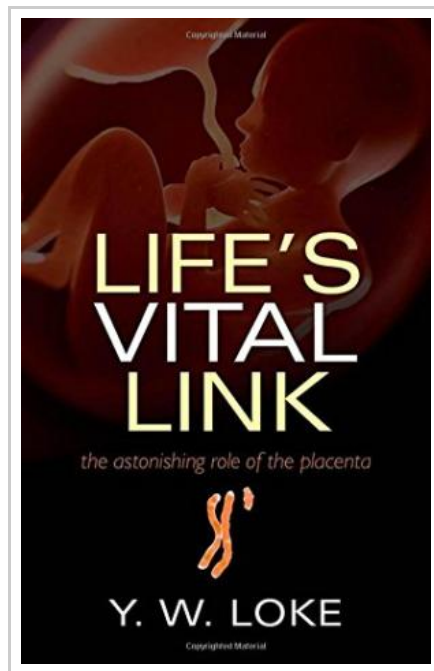




Life's Vital Link
