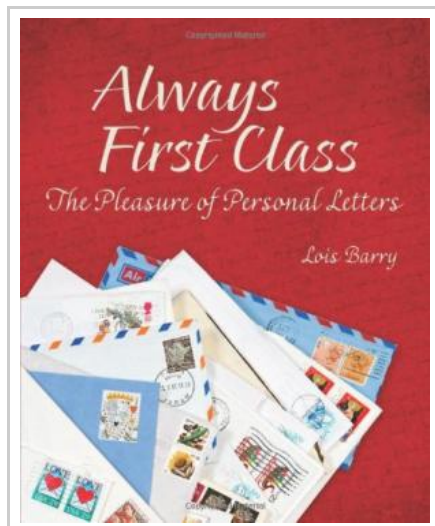




## Always First Class: The Pleasure of Personal Letters
