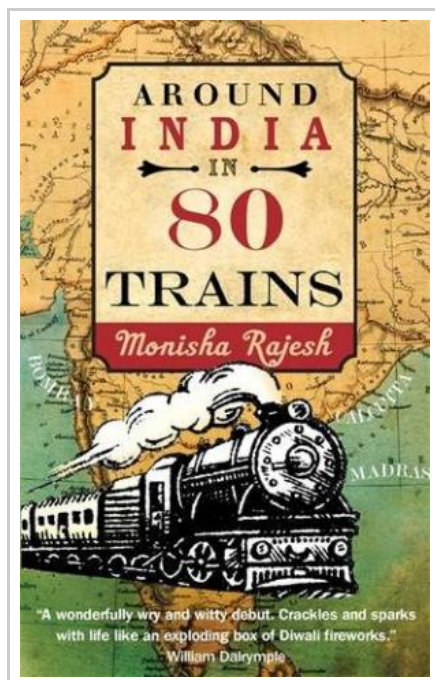




Around India in 80 Trains
