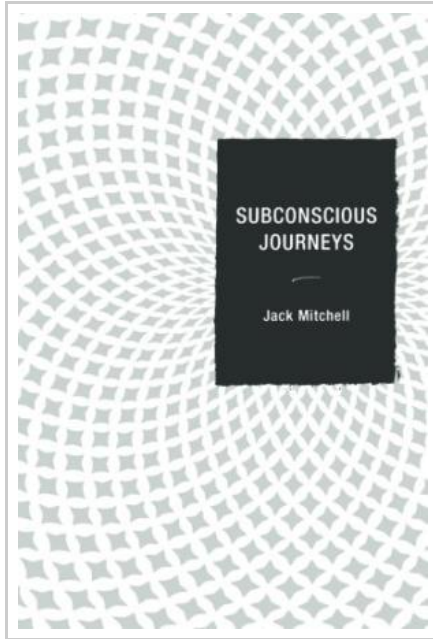




Subconscious Journeys
