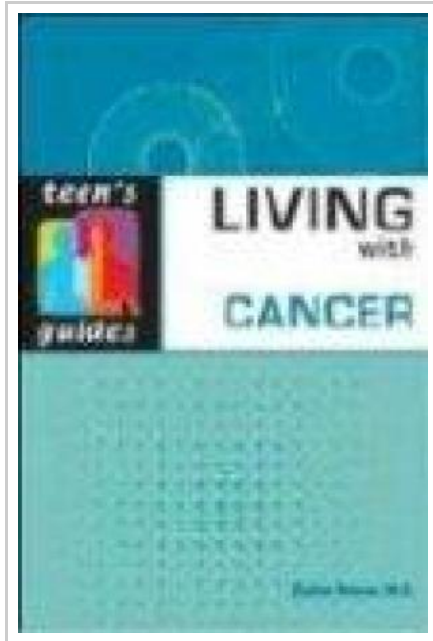




Living with Cancer (Teen's Guides)
